The James River Invitational will be a competitive-style swim meet between the local Richmond and eastern Virginia colleges. Each academic year the schools will meet to compete for the championship title. The winning team each year will be distinguished on a plaque.

- Timing:** Timers will be provided by volunteers from William and Mary. An automatic timing system will also be used.
- Entries:** Entries must be received by Friday, January 26, 2018 at 11:59 PM. Entries should be emailed to swimclub01@email.wm.edu with "James River Invitational [YOUR TEAM NAME] Entries" in the subject line. Please submit entries in Hytek format. If you are unable to use Hytek, please submit entries in an Excel spreadsheet. Note at the end of the "Events" section that there will be TWO Hytek files to submit.
- Entry Limit:** Swimmers may enter in up to 5 individual events and unlimited relays, however they may only score in 3 individual events and 2 relays.
- Meet Fee:** \$15 per swimmer up to 20 swimmers (\$300 max per team). Make checks payable to William & Mary Swim Club. You may bring as many swimmers as you would like.
- Events:** Odd events will be women, even will be men
- 1-2 200 Medley Relay

- 3-4 50 Butterfly
- 5-6 100 Backstroke
- 7-8 100 Breaststroke
- 9-10 50 Freestyle
- 11-12 400 Freestyle Relay
- 13-14 500 Freestyle
- 15-16 50 Backstroke
- 17-18 100 Individual Medley
- 19-20 200 Freestyle
- 21-22 50 Breaststroke
- 23-24 100 Butterfly
- 25-26 100 Freestyle
- 27-28 200 Individual Medley
- 29-30 200 Freestyle Relay
- 31 Flip Cup Relay*

*Flip Cup Relay is an optional event and will not count toward final point totals.

There will be a time trial at the conclusion of the meet for the 200 strokes and 400 IM. These events will not count towards a swimmer's event limit. Please include these in our separate time trial Hytek file.

- 1-2 200 Backstroke
- 3-4 200 Breaststroke
- 5-6 200 Butterfly
- 7-8 400 Individual Medley

Scoring: Swimmers will only be scored in up to 3 individual events, but they can swim more than 3 individual events. The top 2 seed times from each team will race in the last heat of each event. Any swimmer in a previous heat is still eligible to score. Scoring for individual events will be 7-5-3-1 for the top 4 finishers. Relays will be scored 14-10-6-2 for the top 4 finishers. Only two relays will be scored for each team per event.

*If a swimmer signs up for more than 3 individual events, they should note the ones they do not want to be scored in. Otherwise, they will only be scored in the first three individual events they swim.

Facility: The Recreation Center has limited spectator seating. To maximize team spirit on the pool deck, there will be bleacher space available for each team during

the meet. The pool will be set up in 8 lanes SCY. Touchpads will be used and blocks will be available at the starting end of the pool.

Social: We will host a pizza social after the meet for all the teams who would like to attend. **Please let us know if you are planning to join us** and if there are any allergies we need to be aware of. The plaque will be presented at the social before it is engraved. We will then work with the winning team to deliver the engraved plaque at a later date (to be held until the following year).

Parking: Teams are encouraged to park in the parking lot across from the Recreation Center and William & Mary Hall (see map).
