**TIME:** Doors Open at 9:30 AM, Warm-up 10:00-10:55AM, Meet starts at 11:00 AM.

**ENTRY OPTIONS:** Enter On-Line via Club Assistant

OR enter via US.Mail with the Wis. Masters Swimming Universal Entry Form, one athlete per form. On-Line entry preferred. **NO E-MAIL OR DECK LATE ENTRIES FOR INDIVIDUAL EVENTS WILL BE ACCEPTED.**

**FACILITIES:** USMS-measured 50-meter pool with bulkheads, configured as two 8-lane, 25-yard pools, plus one 2-lane, 20-meter pool crosswise. Competition held in 8-lanes of one 25-yard pool. Competition pool water depth: 2 meters (6-1/2 feet) at both start & turn ends. The length of the competition course is in compliance and on file with USMS in accordance with articles 105.1.7 and 106.2.1, but as a bulkhead course, is subject to length confirmation. Eligibility of times for USMS Top 10 and Records will be contingent on verification of bulkhead placement. The bulkhead placement has always met USMS pool length.

**ELIGIBILITY:** Open to all USMS-Registered Masters Swimmers 18 years old or older. Mail entries must include a copy of the current USMS registration card. Note that there are two registration options.

1. USMS Member Annual Registration (Register before entering the meet.)
2. One-Event Registration (\$15). This registration is for the insurance coverage (secondary accident) for the event and registration. It entitles the registrant to swim both days of this meet only and is not an annual USMS athlete registration. Online entry is required for one-event registration. Times swum under one-event registration are not eligible for USMS Top Ten consideration. One-event registrations are also not eligible for USMS or Wisconsin records (individual or relay), All-American or All-Star consideration. One-event swimmers may not swim relays except if the relay is swum as exhibition. One-event registration can be converted to a full USMS membership within 30 days.

**RULES:** Official U.S. Masters Swimming Rules will govern this meet. All events will be timed finals.

**TECHNICAL SWIMSUITS: Rule 102.12.1 D** "Only swimsuits complying with FINA swimsuit specifications may be worn in any USMS sanctioned or recognized competition."

**SEEDING:** Heats will be seeded slowest to fastest, gender and age groups combined. An "NT" is not allowed for an entry. Please estimate your time based on your workouts. The 1000 Free and 1650 Free are the only check-in events. Heat sheets will not be provided, but will be posted around the pool and uploaded to Meet Mobile and Swimphone.com

**SCRATCHES:** If a swimmer fails to swim in his/her assigned heat and lane for an event, the swim will be marked as NS (No Show) and the swimmer will not be allowed to compete in the remaining heats of the event even if there are empty lanes. An exception may be made at the discretion of the official if there has been an error by the official or a meet worker that caused the swimmer to fail to swim in the assigned heat and lane.

**TIMING:** Electronic timing (SST) (primary: automatic) backed up by two buttons (secondary: semi-automatic) and one watch (tertiary). This level of timing meets requirements for setting USMS Records.

**AUTOMATIC SPLIT RECORDING:** Automatic split recording (USMS Rule 103.18.2 A and B) will be performed by the officials for relay lead-off splits, the 500 of the 1000 freestyle and the 500/1000 freestyle split from the 1650 freestyle, provided the split time is available from the automatic (primary) timing system. Other splits must be requested in writing by the swimmer as per USMS rules noted on the USMS Split Notification Form (Appendix B, Page 129 of the 2022 USMS Rule Book).

**WARM-UP PROCEDURE:** On Sunday, both the competition and south pools will be available for warmup during the entire warmup time. On Saturday only, if the swim team is practicing, the warm up will be conducted in the south pool, circle swim only, until the swim team finishes their practice in the competition pool. In this case, there will be at least one-half hour of warmup in the competition pool before the meet starts. Lanes 2, 3 and 7 in the competition pool will open at 10:30 am as start/sprint lanes, swim in one direction only and exit to the side or end. All other lanes, both pools included, are circle swim only. **NO DIVE STARTS OR BACKSTROKE STARTS** from the blocks or deck in circle swim lanes. Entry into the pool must be feet first in a cautious manner. Lanes in the center and south pool are used for warm up & cool downs, circle swim only, no dives or backstroke starts, during the meet and during warm-ups. One lane will be designated for 65 & Over/Special Needs warmup. Swimmers observed diving into any warmup or warm down lane other than designated sprint lanes will be subject to disqualification from all events for the remainder of that day.

**ENTRY FEE:** \$6.00/individual event plus a \$20.00 pool user surcharge in addition to a one-event registration fee applicable only to one-event registrants. Fees must accompany US. Mail entries, CHECKS PAYABLE TO WSAC. Relay-only swimmers must register for the meet, pay the facility fee and sign the waiver. Relay-only swimmers may enter on-line. Relays are free, no cost to enter a relay.

**ENTRY LIMIT:** Six (6) individual events, plus 4 relays. THE 1000 and 1650 FREESTYLES WILL EACH BE LIMITED TO THE FIRST 16 ENTRIES RECEIVED. If the 1000 or 1650 is filled, you may submit an e-mail request to the Meet Director to be added to a waiting list. Each swimmer entered in the 1000/1650 will be responsible for providing a person to count his/her laps.

**RELAYS:** Submit relays at the meet. Relay teams may be all men, all women or mixed (2 men & 2 women). Swimmers may swim 4 relays, but, swimmers may not swim both the mixed and the male/female relays of a given distance. Relay events of the same distance (mixed, male or female) are combined under one event number and swum in the same heat.

**TIME TRIALS:** There are no time trials offered for this meet.

**ENTRY DEADLINE:** Mail entries must be received by Monday, March 21st, 2022. On-line entries will be cut-off on Monday, March 21st, 2022 at 11:59PM central time. **NOTE THAT THE ENTRIES CUTOFF DATE OF MARCH 21, 2022 IS SIX (6) DAYS BEFORE THE MEET.**

**LIABILITY RELEASE:** The LIABILITY RELEASE on the Universal Paper Entry Form for Mail-in Entries must be signed as-is without any alterations.

**AWARDS:** INDIVIDUAL EVENTS: Medals 1st-8<sup>th</sup> place. RELAYS: Ribbons 1<sup>st</sup>-3rd place.

**CONCESSIONS:** The **Elsmore Swim Shop** (<http://www.elsmoreswim.com/>) will be open on Saturday only. There will not be any USMS-identified merchandise available for purchase. Soft drink vending machines with Coca-Cola products will be available, but **no food service will be available** at the meet. Bring your own lunch and snacks.

**HOTELS:** See WSAC website for hotels. The Holiday Inn Express/Candlewood Suites is closest to the WSAC.

**MEET RESULTS:** The USMS Event Rankings and Individual Results website will be updated by Sunday, March 27, and will be available for selection if the swimmer is entering USMS Spring Nationals. Meet Mobile will have results published during the meet.

**ROAD CONSTRUCTION OF HY. 100 AND HY. 57:** There is road construction occurring on the intersection of these highways. The bridge of Hy. 57 over Hy. 100 is being removed and replaced with a grade level intersection. Side roads will need to be used to detour around this construction. Full details will be emailed to participants who have entered the meet.
