California Capital Aquatics (CCA) in Roseville, CA is looking for a qualified Assistant Coach to work part-time with our US Masters Swimming program. Responsibilities would include workout management, informing membership of upcoming USMS events and meets, daily attendance, and could include the opportunity to develop clinics along with time for private lessons, and ability to follow CCA communication and policy requirements. This position would report directly to the CCA Head Coach/CEO. We are looking for a coach who loves the local swimming community and can help our program continue to grow! We have swimmers from novice to those who have many years of swim experience in our group. Our program started in April of 2018 and is now averaging 25 members a month!

Our Weekly Masters schedule is currently listed as:

WEEKDAY EVENINGS: Monday through Thursday 6:45-8PM

WEEKDAY AM: Tues/Thursday 5-6:15AM

Saturday AM: 7-830AM

All workouts will be held at the Roseville Aquatics Complex (3051 Woodcreek Oaks Dr, Roseville).

We are looking for a coach who can commit to **at minimum 4 workouts per week** (Preferably 2 evening workouts, one AM workout, and the Saturday AM workouts). If able to attend more workouts pay would reflect the additional time spent on deck. The coach would then provide workouts for the days they would not attend. (CCA Coaching staff present at the pool for those days would post practices that would be run as "workout groups"). Coach would help develop a regular communication platform for members informing them about upcoming USMS events and activities, along with developing various member incentive programs. Expected "dry side" work per week would be minimal- CCA Staff would assist manage rosters, billing, programming specials, etc.

Preferred experience is 4+ years of US Masters and/or USA Swimming Club experience. The coach is also required to become USA Swimming Certified (CCA will help with cost) and would also receive support to achieve USMS Coaching Certifications. This is a Part-Time hourly position, paid bi-weekly. Compensation for this position will be based on qualifications and availability. Additional benefits would include opportunities for private lessons, development of clinics, and opportunities to help with additional CCA programming for the right candidate.
